

# SINGAPORE YOUTH ART AWARDS

## Rules & Regulations

### 1. Objectives

- The Competition aims to serve as a platform for budding artists to showcase their artistic talents.
- The Competition also wishes to recognize and exhibit works of exceptional quality to the public.
- The above objectives are in line with our mission to promote greater interest in local arts.

### 2. Eligibility

- The Competition is open to students studying in local Secondary Schools, Polytechnics, Junior Colleges and other post-secondary education institutions.
- Students will represent their respective education institutions throughout the course of The Competition.

### 3. Details of The Competition

- The Competition is open to all students who are between the ages of 13 - 21.
- Only 2D painting works are accepted.
- Paintings can be based on any theme(s) and subject matter(s) that the Entrant chooses
- Paintings submitted can be in mediums ranging from Western & Eastern painting: not exceeding 100 cm (w) by 180 cm (h) including outer frame.  
**Note: Any entry exceeding the above limits will not be accepted.**
- Artworks in the medium of photography, video, or those not stipulated above will not be accepted
- The submitted work must be the original artwork the Entrant has done recently
- The title, category, year and medium must be written on the sticker provided, and is to be pasted on the top right hand corner of the back of the painting. Stickers will be issued on the day of submission for all entries

### 4. Submission of Entries

- Entrants must submit their entries together as a school
- Schools must arrange their own transport for the artworks

The collection and administration of all entries will be at The Singapore Art Society at: **140 Hill Street ARTrium@MICA, Friday, 10 August 2012 between 10a.m. -12 noon (Phone: 6733 3822).**

- Submitted artworks must be well framed, dry and fit for exhibiting.
- All schools must fill in the application form regardless of the number of entrants
- Details filled in the application must hold true to all information provided on and about the artworks submitted

5. Entry Form:

All entries must be accompanied with official entry forms. A label carrying the artist name, title should place at the back of each entry.

7. Exhibition:

Selected entries will be exhibited at **140 Hill Street ARtrium@MICA, from 12 August 2012, Sunday till 16 August 2012, Thursday.**

**The opening and prize presentation will be held on Sunday, 12 August 2012, 3 p.m. at 140 Hill Street ARtrium@MICA**

8. Awards:

Participating artworks will be judged and classified into the following categories.

- 1 Gold Awards \$200.00
- 1 Silver Awards \$150.00
- 1 Bronze Awards \$100.00
- 10 Commendation Awards \$20.00
- Certificate of Participation

**Note: All winners must assign to the Singapore Art Society the right of reproducing their works for the purpose of publicity.**

9. Results:

All entries will be judged by a panel of judges appointed by The Singapore Art Society. The decision of the judges is final. No correspondence will be entertained. The judges reserve the right not to award any of the stipulated prizes should the entries fail to meet the required standard.

10. Collection:

Works not selected for exhibition will be notified and must be collected on **Saturday, 11 August 2012, from 2 to 5pm at 140 Hill Street ARtrium@MICA.**

All exhibited entries must be collected on **Thursday, 16 August 2012, from 2 to 5pm at 140 Hill Street ARtrium@MICA.**

**Note: Entries not collected by the given period as above shall be the property of the organiser who will then dispose them off in whatever way they deem fit.**

11. Acceptance:

All entries signify acceptance of the above Rules & Regulations. Whilst all possible care will be taken of for the entries submitted, the organiser assumes no responsibility for any lose or damage to the entries before, during or after exhibition.
